### **EHS Technologies Corp. named third fastest-growing company in S. Jersey**

MAPLE SHADE, NJ – June 16, 2005 – EHS Technologies Corp. was today named the third fastest-growing company in southern New Jersey by *Philadelphia Business Journal* at its *South Jersey 25 Awards Program*. EHS posted a 769.69 percent growth rate over the past three years – improving its position in the top 25 companies from fifth to third.

“We are delighted and proud to have been named among the most successful businesses in south Jersey,” says EHS Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Denise Eckerle. “But business success doesn’t come unless you have great clients and we have been very fortunate to have world-class customers.”

“The only way to achieve growth as a company is through good people,” says EHS President Bill Eckerle. “Hiring good and smart people has been the key to our rapid growth.”

EHS Technologies is a Small Business Administration (SBA) 8a-certified, small woman-owned business formed in November 1996 that provides engineering, environmental, and information technology products and services to government and commercial customers. In addition to its Maple Shade, NJ headquarters, EHS Technologies has an office in Silver Spring, Md. It employs a total of 21 people. Last year, EHS Technologies was named the fifth fastest-growing businesses in south Jersey by *Philadelphia Business Journal*.

Last month, the company received a \$2.8-million award from the U.S. Navy to provide management and technical services to the U.S. Navy at Indian Head, Maryland – the largest contract award in its history. The company was also recently one of several firms to be awarded a contract from the Navy under the innovative SeaPort-E program. The SeaPort-E contract is potentially valued at \$150 billion over a 15-year period.

*South Jersey 25 Awards Program*, in its tenth year, ranks the top 25 fastest-growing private companies in the South Jersey region. The finalists' ranking order was revealed today at the *South Jersey 25 Awards* luncheon at The Mansion in Voorhees, N.J. More than 400 business executives and decision makers from the region’s most successful companies attended the event. The June 17 issue of the *Philadelphia Business Journal* issue will profile and rank the winners in the *South Jersey 25* editorial section.
