EHS Technologies awarded U.S. Navy contract valued at nearly \$2.8 million

MOORESTOWN, N.J. – October 1, 2007 – EHS Technologies has been awarded a contract from the U.S. Navy Naval Surface Warfare Center (NSWC) Indian Head Division valued at nearly \$2.8 million for engineering and technical services. It is the largest competitively bid contract the company has ever been awarded. NSWC Indian Head is part of the Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) and is located in Indian Head, Md.

Under the terms of the contract, EHS Technologies will provide engineering and technical services to support the Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS). LIMS is a database system used by NSWC to track and manage analytical data related to the research and testing of ordnance and energetic materials. Astrix Technology of Edison, N.J. is a key subcontractor to EHS on the contract.

William Eckerle, President of EHS Technologies, says the contract is noteworthy because it was awarded competitively. “Companies like EHS that operate under the umbrella of the Small Business Administration’s 8a program are required to compete for more and more contracts as they grow,” Eckerle explained. “This contract is significant for us because it continues our ongoing relationship with NSWC Indian Head and provides us with our largest competitive win to date.”
